

Standard Wiring Method for Computer Room Power Distribution Box



Article Overview

Proper wiring for a computer room distribution box requires correctly sized conductors, secure grounding, neat cable management, and compliance with NEC and local electrical codes.

Conductor Sizing and Insulation

- Current-carrying conductors should use copper wire with a cross-sectional area of at least 2.5 mm² for power circuits and 1.5 mm² for control or signal circuits, with insulation rated 450/750V or higher .
- Wire connections must be tight without damaging the conductor cores, and bending radii should not be less than the cable's allowable minimum .
- Circuit separation is essential: AC and DC lines, different voltage levels, and computer control lines should be bundled separately and clearly identified .

Grounding and Bonding

- All distribution boxes must have a reliable connection to the protective earth (PE) bar using copper core flexible wires, typically ≥ 4 mm² for main grounding connections .
- Grounding should comply with NEC Article 645.15, ensuring all IT equipment and distribution components are properly bonded to prevent electrical hazards .
- Transformers and high-voltage equipment feeding the distribution box must also be grounded according to design specifications .
