

Standard for connecting hollow cable trays



Article Overview

Hollow cable trays are typically connected using manufacturer-supplied joining pieces, bolts, and nuts, following standards such as NEMA VE 2-2018 and DIN EN 61537.

Joining Methods

Hollow cable trays are joined using couplers or connectors supplied by the tray manufacturer. Each tray section is equipped with flanged edges to ensure rigidity and minimize damage to cable sheaths during handling. Standard joining procedures include:

- Bolts and nuts: Stainless steel bolts and nuts are used to secure adjacent tray sections, often with spring washers to maintain tension and prevent loosening under vibration or thermal expansion .
- Couplers/connectors: For bends, tees, or crossovers, specialized connectors are used to maintain alignment and structural integrity .
- End fittings: End closures or caps may be applied to prevent cable damage and provide a finished appearance .

Material and Hardware Standards

- Stainless steel: Mounting channels, bolts, nuts, and anchor bolts should comply with BS EN 10088-2 Grade 1.4401 (ASTM 316) for corrosion resistance
