

Technical Challenges of 800G Optical Modules Compared to 400G Optical Modules

800G optical modules face higher power, thermal, and signal integrity challenges than 400G modules due to doubled lane speeds, increased density, and advanced modulation requirements.

Electrical and Optical Signaling Complexity

800G modules typically use 8 lanes of 100G ($8 \times 100\text{G}$) compared to 400G modules, which use 8 lanes of 50G ($8 \times 50\text{G}$). Doubling the lane speed introduces significant signal integrity challenges, requiring advanced Digital Signal Processing (DSP) chips, high-speed gearbox technology, and precise PCB trace design to maintain low bit error rates at higher frequencies. The higher data rate per lane also increases susceptibility to crosstalk, jitter, and insertion loss, demanding more sophisticated design and testing.

Power Consumption and Thermal Management

800G modules consume 16–20W or more per port, compared to 10–14W for 400G modules. This higher power density generates more heat, necessitating optimized airflow, heat sinks, or even liquid cooling in high-density deployments. While 800G modules can be more power-efficient per bit, the absolute power per module is higher, which complicates switch and rack-level thermal design.
