No, Layer 3 switches are not inherently all optical; they can have copper, fiber, or a mix of ports depending on the model and deployment.

Layer 3 Switch Port Types

Layer 3 switches have both Layer 2 and Layer 3 ports. Layer 2 ports, also called switchports, connect to VLANs and forward Ethernet frames, while Layer 3 ports are routed ports or Switched Virtual Interfaces (SVIs) configured with IP addresses to interconnect networks . These ports can be copper (RJ45) or fiber (SFP/SFP+/QSFP+), depending on the switch design and intended use .

Optical vs Copper Interfaces

An all-optical switch is a specialized device where all service ports are fiber-optic, eliminating electrical-to-optical conversions and supporting high-speed optical interfaces like 10G, 25G, 40G, or 100G . These are typically deployed in data center cores, aggregation layers, or high-performance computing environments. In contrast, most Layer 3 switches in enterprise or campus networks are hybrid, offering a combination of copper and fiber ports to connect both traditional devices and fiber links .

- Standard Layer 3 switches: Usually have a mix of RJ45 and SFP/SFP+ ports; not all ports are optical....
