

# The number of circuits in the distribution box cannot be determined



## Overview

The most immediate limit on the number of circuits is the physical design of the panel box, defined by the manufacturer's specifications. A standard 200-amp residential panel typically features 30 to 42 physical slots, also referred to as spaces, where circuit breakers can be.
