Grounding Requirements

- **Metal Components:** The metal box, electrical installation board, and any metal base or casing of appliances inside the distribution box must be connected to a grounding conductor .
- **Protective Neutral Connection:** The protective neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board to maintain a continuous grounding path .
- **Leakage Protection:** Installing a leakage protector in the distribution box provides additional safety by detecting ground faults and disconnecting power if necessary .
- **Compliance:** Grounding must comply with local electrical codes, such as the National Electrical Code (NEC) or equivalent regional standards, which require all exposed conductive parts to be grounded
