It receives scaled-down current and voltage signals from current transformers (CTs) and potential transformers (PTs), ensuring that relays operate safely without exposure to high voltages or currents (). These circuits are essential for monitoring, control, and tripping operations in power systems.

Components and Function

- **Current and Voltage Transformers:** Step down high currents and voltages to safe levels for relay operation.
- **Protective Relays:** Receive secondary signals to detect abnormal conditions such as overcurrent, earth faults, or phase faults.
- **Wiring and Busbars:** Connect CTs and PTs to relays, ensuring correct polarity and minimal impedance to maintain accuracy.
- **Trip Circuits:** Activate circuit breakers when a fault is detected, isolating the affected section of the system (). The secondary circuit also includes auxiliary devi...
