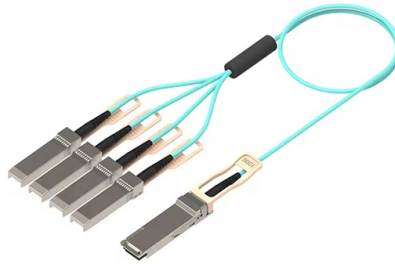

Twisted Pair Cable

Twisted pair cables consist of two insulated copper wires twisted together to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and crosstalk. They come in two main types: Unshielded Twisted Pair (UTP) and Shielded Twisted Pair (STP). UTP is commonly used in Ethernet networks, while STP includes additional shielding for high-interference environments . Advantages:

- Cost-effective and easy to install
 - Supports Power over Ethernet (PoE) for devices like cameras and access points
 - Flexible and suitable for short-distance communication
 - Limited bandwidth and distance
 - Susceptible to EMI without shielding
- Applications: Local Area Networks (LANs), telephony, and small business networks .

Coaxial Cable

Coaxial cables feature a central copper conductor surrounded by insulation, a metallic shield, and an outer protective jacket. This design provides better shielding from external interference and supports higher bandwidth than twisted pair cables . Advantages:...
