Why Two Optical Ports Are Needed

When connecting two network switches via fiber, each switch must have two optical ports—one for transmitting (TX) and one for receiving (RX) signals. This is because fiber optic communication is duplex, meaning data flows simultaneously in both directions over separate strands of fiber . Using a single fiber for both directions requires specialized single-fiber transceivers, but standard SFP modules and most switches rely on duplex (two-strand) fiber connections .

Key Considerations for Fiber Interconnection

- **SFP Transceivers:** Each switch port requires a compatible SFP or SFP+ module. Ensure that both ends use the same type (single-mode or multi-mode) and wavelength to maintain proper communication .
- **Duplex Fiber Cables:** Use pre-terminated duplex fiber cables with LC connectors, connecting TX on one switch to RX on the other and vice versa .
- **Port Rates and Duplex Modes:** Both optical ports should support the same speed (1G, 10G, etc.) and full-duplex mode to avoid mismatches .
- **Distance and Fiber Type:** Choose single-mode fiber for long distances and multi-mode fiber for shorter runs, ensuring the SFP modules match the fiber type .
- **Cabling Orientation:** Correctly reverse the connections between the SFP ports (TX...
