

Using a beam splitter to build a network connection



Overview

A single fiber-optic cable runs from the OLT to a nonpowered (passive) optical beam splitter, which multiplies the signal and relays it to many optical network terminals (ONTs). End-user devices such as PCs and telephones are connected to the ONTs. 1x32 splits were common in North America for G-PON architectures. As XGS-PON continues to be adopted, some service. By dividing a single optical signal from a central Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network. These unassuming devices enable a single optical signal to be divided into multiple paths, making them indispensable for sharing network resources efficiently—from residential FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) connections to large-scale telecom backbones.
