3. Inspect the Endfaces Use a fiber inspection scope to check for scratches, dirt, or defects on the connector endfaces. Damaged connectors can degrade performance and should be replaced .
4. Connect the Patch Cord Align the connectors carefully and insert them into the device ports until they click or lock in place. Avoid forcing the connection, as misalignment can damage the fiber .
5. Manage Bend Radius and Routing Temporary patch cords should follow proper bend-radius rules to prevent excessive stress. Typical indoor patch cords require a minimum bend radius of 10 times the cable diameter. Use cable ties or Velcro straps to secure cords without pinching or kinking them .
6. Label and Document Even for temporary setups, label each patch cord to identify source and destination ports. This reduces confusion and prevents mis-patching during testing or temporary network changes .
