

Vertical distance between cable trays and air ducts



Article Overview

The recommended vertical clearance between the top of a cable tray and the bottom of an air duct is generally at least 300 millimeters (12 inches).

Recommended Clearance

For safe and efficient installation, the vertical distance between cable trays and air ducts should be no less than 300 mm. This spacing ensures proper airflow, prevents obstruction, and allows maintenance access without interference from either system (Apex Tray) . In some installations, especially in high-rise or industrial buildings, maintaining or increasing this clearance may be necessary to accommodate larger ducts or critical airflow requirements.

Additional Considerations

- **Horizontal Clearance:** While vertical spacing is critical, horizontal clearance should also be maintained, typically at least 100 mm, to prevent interference and allow safe access for maintenance (Apex Tray) .
- **Ceiling or Obstruction Clearance:** Cable trays should maintain a minimum distance of 300 mm from ceilings or other overhead obstructions to facilitate installation and heat dissipation (Apex Tray) .
- **Maintenance and Safety:** Adequate vertical spacing prevents airflow restriction, reduces the risk of overheating cables, and ensures that technicians can safely inspect or replace cables without obstruction (Apex Tray)
