The tubes can be further protected with outer buffering to enhance durability and environmental resistance (Fibercore) .

Stainless Steel Fiber Optic Tubes

Stainless steel tubes, sometimes called FIST (Fiber in Steel Tube), are designed for harsh environments. They are often flooded with a thixotropic filling compound and hermetically sealed to protect fibers from moisture, chemical exposure, and mechanical stress. These tubes are commonly integrated into armored cables and subsea umbilicals, ensuring flexibility, optical signal integrity, and long-term durability (AFL)
