Fiber Type and Color Coding

- Single-mode pigtails (OS1/OS2): Typically have yellow jackets and are used for long-distance transmission, telecom networks, FTTH, and data centers. They operate at wavelengths of 1310nm or 1550nm and can cover distances up to 10-40 km .
- Multimode pigtails (OM1-OM5): Color-coded as orange (OM1/OM2), aqua (OM3/OM4), or violet (OM5). These are suitable for short-distance connections, enterprise LANs, data centers, and parallel optics, typically operating at 850nm with distances up to 500m .

Connector Types

Colored pigtails are also classified by the connector type, which determines compatibility with equipment:

- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, duplex-friendly, widely used in data centers.
- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square push-pull connector, common in telecom and FTTH....
