

What cables should be placed in a standard high-voltage cable tray



Article Overview

For high voltage cables, it is recommended to use cable trays made of hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel for optimal heat dissipation and safety.

Recommended Cable Tray Types

- Ladder Cable Tray:
 - This type features two side rails connected by rungs, allowing for excellent ventilation and heat dissipation. It is particularly effective for supporting heavy-duty cables over long distances, making it suitable for high voltage applications. The open design also facilitates easy access for maintenance and upgrades .
- Perforated Cable Tray:
 - With a flat bottom and numerous ventilation holes, this tray type provides good support while allowing air circulation to reduce heat buildup. It is suitable for moderate cable loads and can be used in environments where heat dissipation is necessary .
- Solid-Bottom Cable Tray:
 - While this type offers complete coverage for cables, it is generally used for sensitive cables like fiber optics. However, it can be used for high voltage cables if electromagnetic interference is a concern .
