Conversely, it can also combine multiple optical signals into a single fiber, acting as a bidirectional distribution point.

How It Works

The splitter operates by fusing and tapering optical fibers to create a coupling region where light is redistributed among the output fibers. The process relies on the physics of light propagation in fiber cores, ensuring that the signal is divided according to a predetermined split ratio (e.g., 1x2, 1x4, 1x8, 1x32, 1x64). Key performance metrics include:

- **Insertion Loss:** The reduction in signal power due to splitting. Higher split ratios result in greater insertion loss.
- **Split Ratio:** Determines how the input power is distributed among outputs.
- **Uniformity:** Measures how evenly the signal is distributed across all output ports....
