

What does fiber optic communication use for transmission

Fiber optic communication transmits data as pulses of light through optical fibers, offering high-speed, long-distance, and interference-free transmission.

Principles of Fiber Optic Transmission

Fiber optic communication works by converting electrical signals into light pulses, which travel through an optical fiber using the principle of total internal reflection. The fiber consists of a core (where light propagates) surrounded by a cladding with a slightly lower refractive index, which confines the light within the core and allows it to travel long distances with minimal loss. Light sources, typically laser diodes (LDs) or light-emitting diodes (LEDs), generate the optical signals, while photodiodes at the receiver convert the light back into electrical signals.

Components of a Fiber Optic Communication System

- Transmitter: Converts electrical input signals into optical signals using a light source and a source driver circuit.
- Optical Fiber: Acts as the transmission medium, guiding light pulses over long distances with low attenuation (~ 0.2 dB/km) and high bandwidth (up to THz).
- Receiver: Detects the incoming light pulses and converts them back into electrical signals using photodetectors.
- Amplifiers/Repeaters: Boost the signal strength for long-distance transmission, extending the reach of the system without significant degradation
