

# What does the end of a fiber optic cable refer to

- **Ferrule:** A thin cylindrical structure, usually made of ceramic, metal, or high-quality plastic, that holds the fiber in place and ensures precise alignment with the mating fiber .
- **Connector body:** The housing that supports the ferrule and attaches to the cable jacket, providing mechanical strength .
- **Coupling mechanism:** A latch, bayonet, or snap-in system that secures the connector to another device or adapter . Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, and FC, each with specific designs for single-mode or multimode fibers . Some connectors are pre-polished for easier installation, while others require cleaving and polishing during termination .
