

What is KD in relay protection



Article Overview

In relay protection, "KD" refers to a type of compensator distance relay used for phase fault detection and tripping in power systems.

Overview of KD Relays

The KD relay is a polyphase compensator distance relay designed to provide a single zone of phase protection for all three phases. It is capable of detecting phase-to-phase faults, two-phase-to-ground faults, and three-phase faults, and provides essentially instantaneous tripping within its reach and sensitivity settings (ABB KD-4, KD-10) . KD relays are widely used in directional and impedance relaying schemes.

Function of the Compensator

The "KD" designation is associated with the compensator mechanism within the relay. The compensator is typically a current-to-voltage air gap transformer (designated as T, TAB, or TBC) that produces a voltage proportional to the phase current. One section of the compensator winding is connected subtractively in series with the relay terminal voltage, effectively vectorially subtracting a voltage proportional to the current from the terminal voltage. This allows the relay to measure impedance accurately and respond to faults within a specific zone .
