A busbar bridge in switchgear is a connection system that links multiple devices within a switchboard, distributing current from the main busbar to downstream components safely and efficiently.

Overview of Busbars in Switchgear

A busbar is a metallic conductor, typically made of copper or aluminum, housed inside switchgear to distribute high currents between incoming power sources, circuit breakers, and outgoing feeders . Busbars can be rigid, flexible, flat, tubular, or laminated, with their design optimized for current capacity, thermal performance, mechanical strength, and insulation . Proper busbar design ensures stable operation under normal and short-circuit conditions, reduces maintenance, and enhances switchgear longevity .

Function of a Busbar Bridge

A busbar bridge (or bridge line) is a section of conductor that connects devices located in the same switchboard, effectively linking the main busbar to downstream equipment . These bridges can be positioned at the top or bottom of the conduit:

- Top bridge lines connect upstream elements, distributing current from the main busbar to multiple devices.
 - Bottom bridge lines connect downstream elements, ensuring that current flows from the busbar to protective devices, breakers, or other switchgear components .
- The busbar acts as a current distributor, allowing bridge lines to carry reduced cabl...
