 - Simple, cost-effective, and suitable for basic light detection ().
 - Commonly used in night lights, light-activated switches, and basic ambient light sensing.
- Photodiodes
 - Convert light into current, offering fast response and linear output.
 - Can operate in photovoltaic mode (zero bias, low noise) or photoconductive mode (reverse-biased, faster response) ().
 - Ideal for applications requiring precise and rapid light measurement....
