Role of Routers

A router is a networking device that manages and directs data traffic between devices on a local network and the internet. It examines data packets and forwards them to their correct destinations, assigns IP addresses via DHCP, and often provides security features like firewalls . Routers do not transmit data over fiber directly; instead, they rely on signals converted from optical to electrical form.
