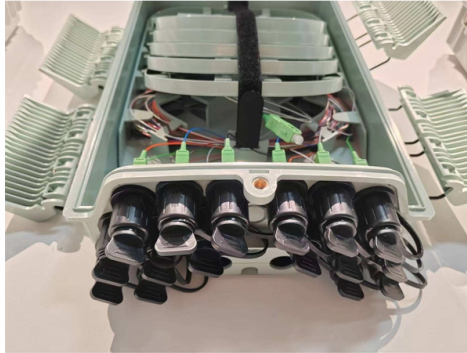


What quota should be applied to the hole opening in the cable tray wall
