The blue appearance on a beam splitter is typically due to a thin dielectric coating applied to control reflection and transmission of light.

Beam splitters are optical devices that divide an incoming light beam into two separate beams, one reflected and one transmitted, and they are widely used in interferometers, laser systems, and imaging setups . The "blue thing" you see is usually a thin-film dielectric coating applied to the surface of the glass or prism. These coatings are designed to achieve a specific reflection-to-transmission (R/T) ratio at certain wavelengths, often around 50/50 for standard beam splitters . The blue color arises from interference effects in the thin layers of the coating. When light hits the coated surface, some wavelengths are reflected more strongly than others due to constructive and destructive interference, producing a visible tint. Blue is a common color because many coatings are optimized for visible light, and the thickness of the layers is tuned to reflect shorter wavelengths more efficiently . Different types of beam splitters may have different coatings:

- Cube beam splitters consist of two right-angle prisms cemented together, with one hypotenuse coated with a dielectric film .
- Plate beam splitters are flat glass plates with a coating on one surface and often an anti-reflective coating on the opposite side to reduce unwanted reflections . In addition to controlling the R/T ratio, these coatings can also minimize ghost reflections, improve polarization performance, and protect the underlying glass.
