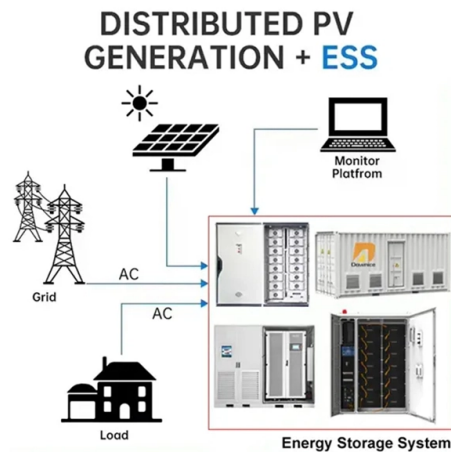


What type of copper busbar is used in the distribution box
