

Where is the fiber optic cable located on the tower



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables on a tower are typically routed along the tower structure, secured with clamps, and connected to the base or mast equipment to provide backhaul connectivity.

Placement and Routing

Fiber optic cables are generally installed vertically along the tower structure, either inside conduits or freely hung with proper hoisting grips for monopoles. They are fixed at intervals of 0.8–1 meter vertically and 1 meter horizontally to prevent contact with the tower and avoid damage from twisting or wind movement. The cable must never touch the metal structure directly and is often protected with installation tubes or pulling socks during deployment to maintain integrity and prevent bending beyond safe limits .

Connection Points

The fiber typically runs from the ground-level distribution or mast box up to the antennas or radio equipment. At the top, it connects to the radio remote modules (RRM) or other active equipment, while at the bottom, it links to the backhaul network, which transports data to the core network. This backhaul is critical for high-speed data transmission, especially for 4G and 5G networks .
