

# Where is the relay protection trip contact located



## Overview

Between 27-28 terminals lies the operating coil of the relay in a series of its own NC contact, which helps to automatically cut off the supply to the coil once it is triggered. Figure 5 – Contact multiplication principle of master trip relay

The protection relay tripping circuit refers to the critical electrical control loop that executes trip/close commands from protective relays to circuit breakers, ensuring rapid fault isolation in power systems. This system integrates protection logic with breaker control functions. Certain conditions, like low gas pressure in SF<sub>6</sub> circuit breaker or low air pressure in pneumatic circuit breakers, require that the circuit breaker not trip, even if a fault current is. The coil of the series contactor carries the trip current initiated by the protection relay, and the contactor closes a contact in parallel with the protection relay contact.

4 The first protective relays were electromagnetic devices, relying on coils operating on moving parts to provide detection of abnormal operating conditions such as. Master Trip is an auxiliary relay which works as intermediate between multiple protection relay and circuit breaker trip coil. Master trip relay is not a monitoring relay.
