

Which core layer switches are better

The best core layer switches are high-performance Layer 3 switches with high port density, robust throughput, low latency, and strong redundancy features.

Key Features of Core Switches

Core switches act as the backbone of a network, aggregating traffic from distribution switches and ensuring ultra-fast, reliable data forwarding across the network . Unlike access or distribution switches, core switches are designed for high-capacity, high-speed environments, often supporting 10G, 40G, or even 100G ports . They are primarily Layer 3 devices, capable of advanced routing, VLAN segmentation, and QoS management .

Performance Considerations

- Port Type, Speed, and Quantity: Choose switches with sufficient uplink ports and diverse port types to accommodate current and future network growth. For example, 10G or 40G uplinks are standard for modern core switches .
- Backplane Bandwidth: A higher backplane bandwidth ensures non-blocking, full-duplex data transfer. The minimum standard is calculated as number of ports $\times$ port rate $\times 2$.
- Forwarding Rate: Core switches must handle massive traffic efficiently. The forwarding rate should exceed that of access and distribution switches, calculated based on the number and speed of ports .
