

Which port should the optical splitter connect to for power



Article Overview

Optical splitters are passive devices and do not require a power connection; the input port should be connected to the optical signal source, such as an OLT, while the output ports connect to the ONTs or end devices.

Understanding Splitter Ports

Optical splitters have clearly defined input and output ports. The input port receives the optical signal from the source, typically an OLT (Optical Line Terminal) in a PON network, while the output ports distribute the signal to multiple endpoints, such as ONTs (Optical Network Terminals) or subscriber devices . For example, a 1:32 splitter has one input port and 32 output ports, and a 2:32 splitter has two input ports for redundancy .

Passive Operation

Splitters are passive components, meaning they do not contain active electronics and therefore do not require external power . They function by splitting the incoming optical signal into multiple outputs, with some inherent signal loss depending on the split ratio (e.g., 3 dB loss for a 1:2 split), . Because they are passive, connecting a power source to any port is unnecessary and will not affect operation.

Correct Connection Procedure

- Input Port: Connect the fiber carrying the optical signal from the OLT or other sour...
