It also helps maintain the cable's minimum bending radius, which is critical for preserving optical performance during routing around machinery or tight spaces .

Environmental and Chemical Resistance

Fiber optic cables are often exposed to temperature fluctuations, moisture, UV radiation, and chemical agents such as acids, alkalis, or oils. The sheath provides a protective layer that resists corrosion, water ingress, and degradation from environmental exposure, allowing the cable to maintain its functionality over a typical service life of 20 years or more .

Fire Safety

In indoor installations, especially in data centers or buildings, the sheath also serves as a fire-retardant barrier. Materials like LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), PVC, or Plenum-rated sheaths reduce smoke and toxic gas emissions during a fire, helping...
