Cables and wires can be placed in the same cable tray if they meet NEC requirements, but power, control, and communication cables may require separation or barriers depending on voltage and interference concerns.

NEC Guidelines and Safety Considerations

According to NEC Article 392, cable trays are designed to support various types of electrical conductors, including service conductors, feeders, branch circuits, communications circuits, and control circuits, in both industrial and commercial buildings (392.3) . Cables rated 600 volts or less can generally be installed together in the same tray without additional separation, provided the tray is not overfilled and cables are properly supported and secured . For cables operating above 600 volts, a solid barrier or Type MC cable is required to separate them from lower-voltage cables to prevent electrical hazards and maintain safety . This ensures that high-voltage cables do not induce interference or pose a risk to lower-voltage circuits.

Separation and Interference

Mixing different types of cables, such as power and data cables, can lead to electromagnetic interference (EMI) if not properly managed. Best practices include:

- Using dividers within the tray to create physical separation between power and sensitive signal cables
