Optical fiber cables transmit data using light signals guided by the principle of total internal reflection.

Structure of Optical Fiber

An optical fiber consists of three main layers:

- Core: The central part made of high-purity glass or plastic through which light travels.
- Cladding: Surrounds the core and has a lower refractive index, keeping light confined within the core.
- Buffer Coating: A protective layer that shields the fiber from physical damage and moisture. The core and cladding are designed with specific refractive indices to ensure light remains within the core during transmission.

Total Internal Reflection

The fundamental working principle of optical fibers is total internal reflection (TIR). When a light ray enters the fiber, it strikes the boundary between the core and cladding at an angle greater than the critical angle. This causes the light to be completely reflected back into the core, allowing it to zig-zag along the fiber with minimal energy loss. For TIR to occur:

- Light must travel from a denser medium (core) to a less dense medium (cladding).
- The angle of incidence must exceed the critical angle. This mechanism ensures that light signals, encoded as pulses, can travel long distances without escaping the...
